- 🔗 **Partners in Survival™**- First of its kind educational workshops developed by MSWWC to help men navigate the crisis of breast cancer utilizing a proven evidence-based problem-solving model
Your support of \$1500 provides a workshop in the DMV Region
- 🔗 **For The Women We Love: A Breast Cancer Caregiver's Battle Plan and Action Guide for Men**- Providing men the tools and guide using the C.O.P.E Model of caregiving
Your support of \$500 helps send 30 books to a designated health care organization or those in the DMV Region
- 🔗 **It's Not Rocket Science: A Guy's Blueprint to Caregiving**- No nonsense, straight talk perspective on what it takes for guys to be great caregivers using real life situations shared across the country by health care providers and most importantly, men and their families MSWWC has worked

- 🔗 **Caregiver Tool Kit for Men**- distributed at diagnosis to assist men and their families providing helpful information on what is needed to be an educated and empowered caregiver.

- 🔗 **Caregiver Navigator**- Develop and/or enhance current networks in health care organizations providing support to the male caregiver at the time of diagnosis to actively engage him at the beginning of the journey

MSWWC has delivered its Partners in Survival™ program in 37 states, and Canada

MSWWC has sent educational materials to all 50 states; as well as, Canada, Italy, Spain, Kenya, Japan, and Lebanon

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) awarded MSWWC the first of its kind \$1.1 million to expand and develop our innovative programming

In 2007, we held the first ever Male's Caregiver Conference to empower men to be there for the women they love
